ENTRANCE REQUIRMENTS:

- i. A 3-Year General or a 4-year Honours Bachelor's degree from an accredited University.
- ii. Ontario Grade 12 "U" level Advanced Functions and Introductory Calculus and Geometry and Discrete Mathematics or equivalent courses.
- iii. Students lacking Grade 12 "U" Advanced Functions and Introductory Calculus, Geometry and Discrete Mathematics or equivalent courses will require additional time to complete all of the requirements for the degree.

Procedures for applying for the Program:

All Students, including International students, may apply to

- Ontario Application Centre (www.ouac.on.ca), using the OUAC 105 application if you are a Canadian citizen, a permanent resident or an international student residing in Canada;
- Applicants residing in Canada may apply directly to the University of Windsor three weeks prior to the commencement of classes;
- Former or current students may apply online using the Student Information System (SIS). If your log-in is no longer valid, contact the Office of the Registrar;
- International Students may apply by visiting www.uwindsor.ca/isc, go to Admissions Information (on the left) and then follow the drop down menu link Application Forms. You can find the International on-line applications, along with instructions to apply.
